co-chairs for the 2007 event, **Jennifer Eagle** and **Catherine Rose**

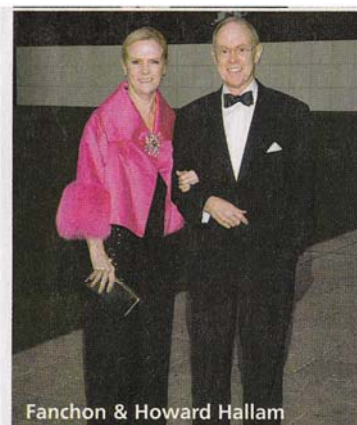
On the Block:
